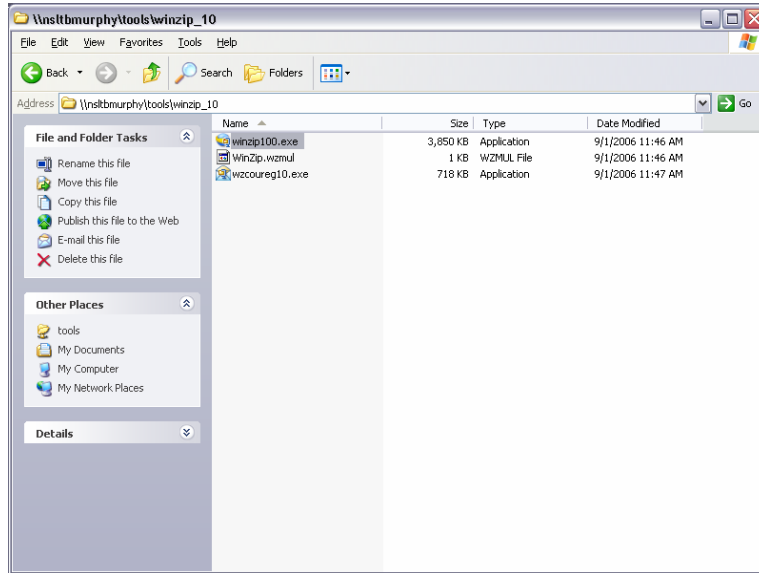


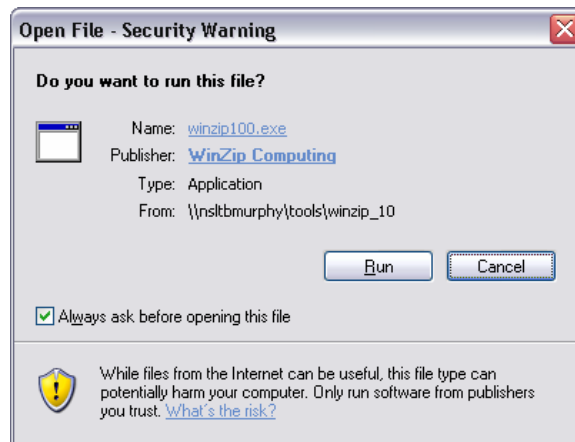
How to set up Winzip for Windows....

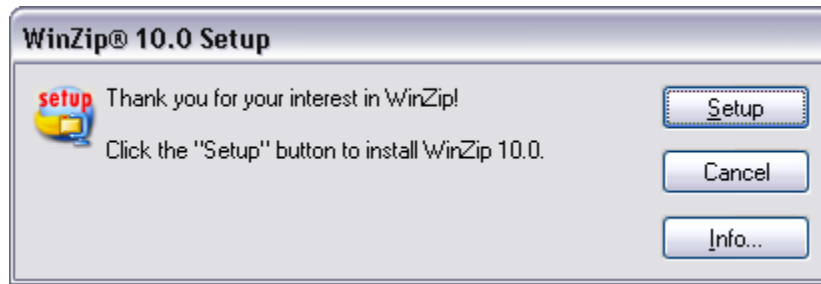
1. Go to www.nwos-spokane.com web page and at the bottom of the main page you will see a “Help Desk” link. Please use this link and go to the Help Desk page. Double click on the “Winzip” link under applications to get the downloads. Choose “Run” twice to get the download started.
2. The downloads will go to your “c:\temp” folder.



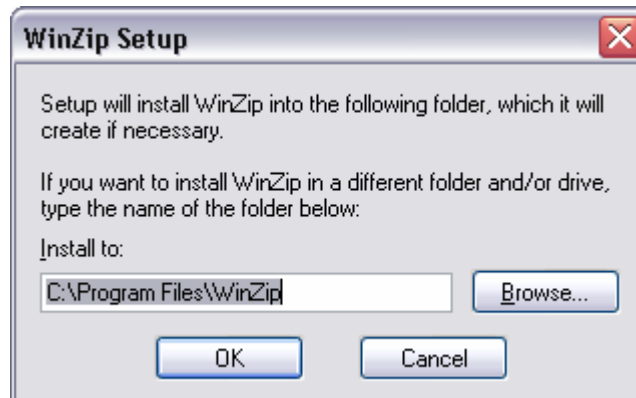
3. Go to the “c:\temp” folder and double click on and run the “winzip100.exe” file.
4. Please leave this folder open, as you will need to go back to at the end of this process.



5. Click on “Run.”



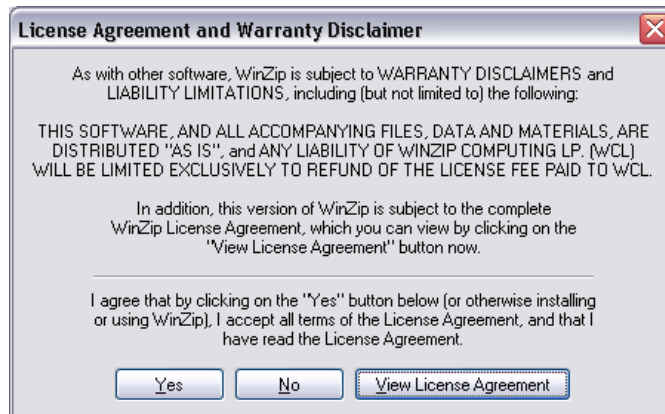
6. Click on "Setup."

8. Click on "Next."



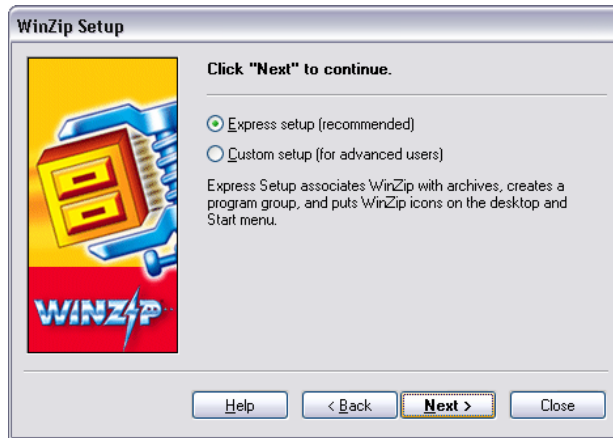
9. Click on "Yes."



10. Click on "Next."



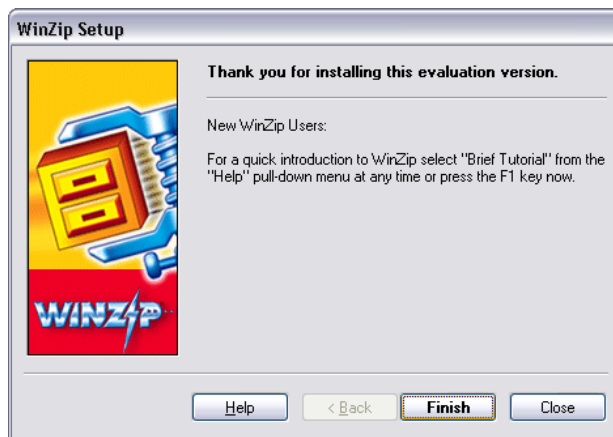
11. Click on "Next."



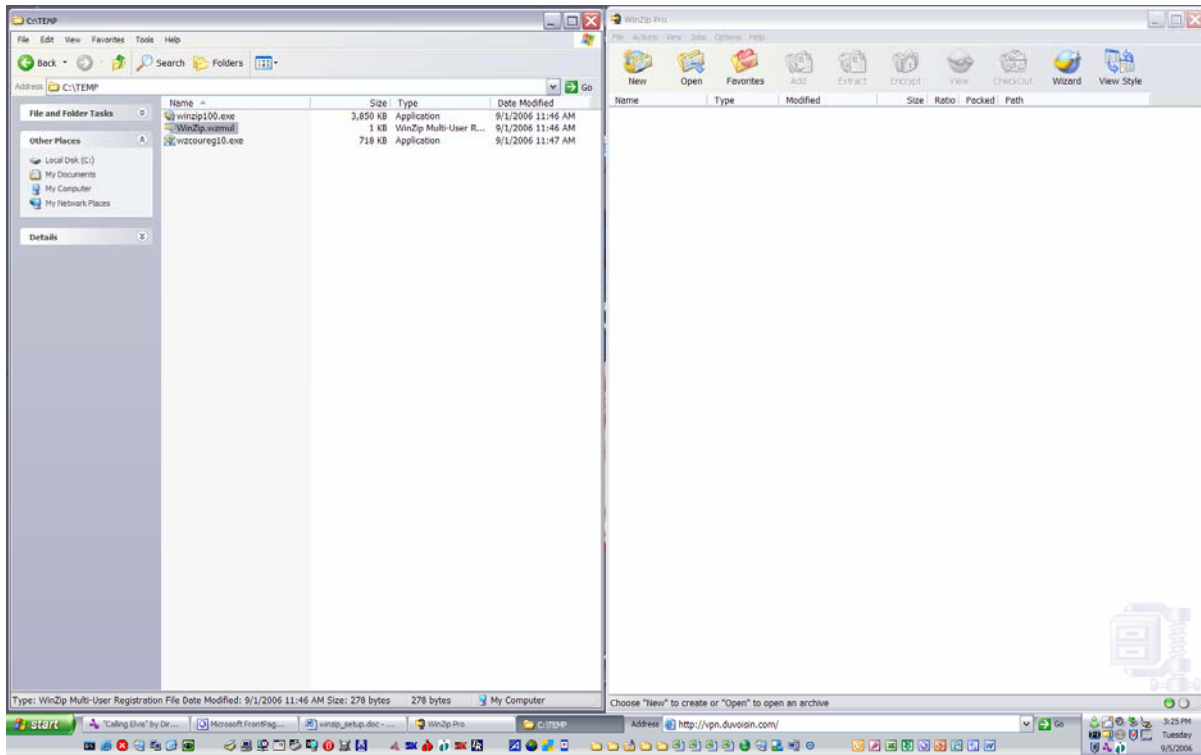
12. Click on "Next."



13. Click on "Next."

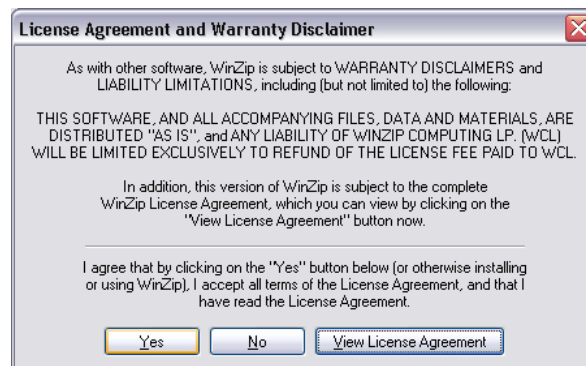


14. Click on "Finish."

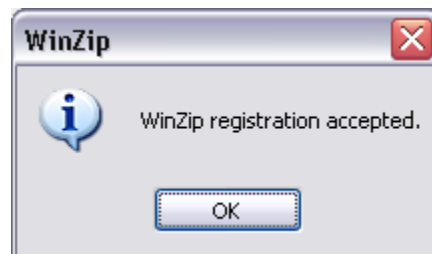


15. Now we need to license Winzip. Go back to the “c:\temp” folder. With your mouse left click on “WinZip.wzmul” file and hold down your mouse button. Drag the “WinZip.wzmul” file over to the “Winzip” window and release or drop the file on a open spot in the Winzip application and choose.

16. This will pop up your license agreement.



17. Click on “Yes.”



18. Click on “OK.”

19. Close Winzip.
